Rabbi Henry G. Brandt has passed away

and we mourn the loss of a person who rendered outstanding services to the Jewish-Christian dialogue in our region. As state rabbi in Westphalia-Lippe (1995-2004), he is still vividly remembered by many older people from that time. They experienced him as a spiritual and liberal discussion partner at weekend seminars in Haus Stapelage or at the openings of the memorials of former synagogues in Lemgo and Bad Salzuflen. Henry G. Brandt was a welcome guest at Haus Münsterberg in Detmold, the seat of the Christian-Jewish Society in Lippe.

We will cherish his memory with gratitude.
