In a small ceremonial setting, designed by students of the Heinrich-Drake-Realschule, stumbling blocks for members of the Buchholz family are laid by the artist Gunter Demnig in the presence of Mayor Hilker in front of the house at Sachsenstr. 25.

Followed by the laying of a stumbling stone for Paula Paradies in front of Krumme Str. 20.

Students of the Grabbe arrange the laying of a stumbling stone in memory of the Jewish school and its students and teachers in Gartenstraße, in front of No. 6.

# **Reading Circle**


The novel "The Land of Others" by Leïla Slimani is to be discussed.
