Alexander Estis is a writer and columnist. He was born into a Jewish artistic family in Moscow in 1986. in 1996 he moved to Hamburg with his parents. After graduating, he

taught German language and literature at various universities. He has been living as a freelance author in Aarau since 2016.

Alexander Estis works mainly in small literary forms; these include prose, lyrical and scenic miniatures. A special feature of his work - in addition to stylistic diversity - is the fusion of prose and metrical form, of satire and seriousness, of essayistic and fiction, and of word and image.

Jakow Zelewitsch has been cantor of the Jewish community of Herford-Detmold since 2003. He was born in eastern Ukraine in 1946, has lived in Germany since 1991 and has worked as a cantor in various Jewish communities since 1994. Music and religion have accompanied him since childhood. He completed his vocal training at the Eugenija Tamgorowa Conservatory in Riga.

His daughter, the teacher and pianist Julia Leitschkis, completed her training at the Detmold Conservatory in 2000. Since then she has worked as a piano teacher at various music schools.

The two have already given several concerts together.

## "A simple act of reparation?" - The Jewish Community of Detmold in the Post-War Period"

### A lecture by Gudrun Mitschke-Buchholz

Only a few Detmold Jews returned to the city from which they had been expelled after the end of the war. Destitute, sick and scarred by the catastrophe of the genocide, they often faced mistrust and resentment. The "rest of the rescued" built up a new community life together with Silesian Jews. The lecture traces the difficult re-establishment of the Jewish community,



which had to struggle for an undignified long time to find a place of worship.

Gudrun Mitschke-Buchholz is the author of the memorial book of the city of Detmold and works at the Detmold city archive.

## After the Crisis - Paths of Jewish Society into the Modern Era

### A lecture by Dr Rotraud Ries

The Middle Ages ended with a fundamental crisis for the Jews in the Old Empire. As a result of the expulsions from the imperial cities and many other places, the Jewish infrastructure had been largely destroyed, education and scholarship had been greatly reduced and traditional literature was hardly available. The economic capacity was no longer sufficient for larger businesses.

The lecture shows how Jewish society succeeded in adapting to the new conditions and how Jewish life developed again very gradually and with great regional differences. The Principality of Lippe will also play a role.

Dr. Rotraud Ries studied medieval and modern history, Jewish studies and Protestant theology with a focus on Jewish history in Münster, Westphalia. Her doctorate was followed by several research projects in the field of early modern Jewish history. Since 2007 she has worked first at the Jewish Museum Berlin and from 2009 to 2022 as director of the Johanna Stahl Centre for Jewish History and Culture in Lower Franconia.
